  - (a) Who do these representatives serve?
  - (b) What are their functions?
  - (c) Outline facilities that must be made available to them.
- 3. A joinery firm has won a contract to provide hardwood joinery for a new branch of a building society. Two types of hardwood are specified.
  - (a) List the factors to be taken into consideration when selecting the timber.
  - (b) Describe all the necessary measures to ensure quality control from site measurement to completion.
  - (c) Write a specification for the work.
- 4. A small builder wishes to employ a foreman for work of good quality including jobbing. Describe the qualities and attributes which would be looked for when interviewing candidates.
- 5. Carpenters and Joiners should be familiar with BS 5268
  - (a) State the full name of this document.
  - (b) Describe one of the areas covered by this document.
- 6. (a) State **six** ways in which the craft foreman can help to maintain or develop a high morale among his/her work force.
  - (b) List **five** factors that a company might use to motivate individuals towards higher quality work.
- 7. Briefly define the following:-
  - (a) All-in rate; (b) Nominated sub-contractor; (c) Provisional sums;
  - (d) Fixed price tender; (e) Penalty clause.
- 8. Describe the use of the following in the planning of construction projects:-
  - (a) Bar charts; (b) Network analysis.
